MEETING  
DECEMBER 8, 2014

Mtg. called to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:00 pm by Mayor Griffin.

Roll call taken:

In attendance – Mayor Griffin, Commissioners Doll, Henry, Wilbert and Strange. Lt. Cabrera, Mark Madison, John Singler (late).

Absent – Pat Cooke

Commissioner Henry motioned to approve the Nov. minutes and Commissioner Doll 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Finance – Commissioner Wilbert reported we have \$238,515 in our accounts with \$120K in tax bills still due. Commissioner Wilbert made a motion to pay the bills, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Henry.

Works – Commissioner Doll reported all is calm.

Sanitation – Commissioner Henry stated no issues to report. She reminded that the ban on plastic yard waste bags goes into effect Jan. 1 and that the last newsletter contained suggestions from Waste Mgmt. on alternatives.

Safety – Commissioner Strange reported that during Nov. there were 7 citations for speeding or parking, 1 citation for reckless driving, and 1 arrest for shoplifting in the Walmart store. She also noted that a resident called to complain about solicitation by ASAP renovations. When she noted to them that they couldn't go door to door, they stated that they "had permission". Attorney Singler will send them a letter.


Lt. Cabrera reminded residents to keep an eye on all packages while shopping, lock them in your trunk, take them in the house when returning home, and park in well-lit areas.
