REPORTS:

Finance: Commissioner Knoop. Motion by Gayle Knoop to pay the monthly bills, seconded by Sharon Doll and the vote in favor was unanimous.

Safety: Commissioner Strange. 1 parking violation, 8 business checks, 10 traffic stops. There was the normal increase in activity for the holiday season.


Sanitation: Commissioner Henry: There were a few calls, but nothing out of the ordinary.


Public Works: Commissioner Doll: Discussion as to fixing several signs and replacing mail boxes. Discussion as to contacting the new retirement center as to whether they need a box or not.

Attorney Report: There was follow up on the dead tree issue reported at 57 Narwood, which dead tree is located on the property of the office complex behind this residence. The office complex has been put on notice and they are reviewing the issue and will respond. The resident has been informed. There is a proposal from the Jefferson County League of Cities to try and attract a new telecommunication provider to the Louisville area to install a high speed internet system based on fiber optic cable. Google Fiber seems interested, many meetings have been held and the Jefferson County League of Cities is recommending that all cities enter into an agreement with Louisville Metro, allowing Louisville Metro to negotiate a county-wide franchise agreement. A proposed agreement with Louisville Metro was distributed and discussed. Motion made by Gayle Knoop to approve the agreement, seconded by Sharon Henry and the vote in favor was unanimous.

With no further business, Mayor Griffin adjourned the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
