

CITY OF FOREST HILLS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
March 20, 2017

Mayor Kenny Griffin opened the regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church.

City Commissioner Members: Kenneth Griffin (Mayor), Sharon Doll (Public Works), Sharon Henry (Finance/Landscaping), Susie Strange (Safety), and Lydia Moel (Sanitation).

City Employees: NSAP Lt. Hondro Cabrera (police officer), Pat Cooke (Clerk/Treasurer), John Singler (attorney) and Mark Madison (City Engineer & Code Enforcement Officer).

Others Present: Church member Jim Ayres

Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call: All present except Mark Madison.

Mayor Griffin asked for a moment of silence in memory of Clerk Pat Cooke's mother who died last month.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed, one correction made and a motion to approve was made by Com. Strange, seconded by Com. Henry. Motion carried.

Reports:

Finance: She reported total bank accounts were \$356,227 and accounts receivable were down to \$1,557. A motion was made to pay the bills by Com. Henry, seconded by Com. Moel. Motion carried.

Com. Henry said that she had received a notice about a zoning meeting to be held later in the month at the Old County Jail. This has to do with the proposed Hwang acquisition.

Sanitation: Com. Moel reported that activity has been quiet except for a few instances. She has already received some RSVP responses for the Easter egg hunt including sponsors. She brought up the previously mentioned possibility of a Facebook page for the City. She said it would be a way to better communicate with the younger people in the City. She would be the administrator and monitor the activity and posts. A motion was made for trying a Facebook page by Com. Moel, seconded by Com. Strange, motion carried.

Public Safety: No problems except some door to door solicitations from AT&T. It was suggested that copies of the ordinance pertaining to solicitation be given to Lt. Cabrera to hand out to these people. The City Attorney explained the difference between what is needed to solicitate in the City of Louisville and smaller cities.



Public Works: A representative from Council member Marilyn Parker's office will attend the next meeting to discuss financial help fixing the many sidewalk issues that have been proposed by a contracting company that visited at the last meeting.

City Clerk: The cell phone contract came up for renewal and after talking with a representative, AT&T said they had a new plan for \$30 less per month which was signed up for. The Clerk will be out of the office from March 31st to April 7th.

Attorney Singler: All money due to the City for 9218 Axminster has been received and the lien release has been filed. He will also investigate the status of the property at 2206 Janlyn that has been empty and possibly abandoned.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
