REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
JANUARY 10, 2022

Mayor Kenny Griffin opened the regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church.

Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call:

The landlord, Community of Christ Church, wants to raise the rent to \$350 for the city office at the Church. A motion was made by Commissioner Sharon Henry to approve, Commissioner Sharon Doll seconded and all approved.

Sanitation/ Events: Lydia Moel reported that there is garbage in the back of the Hwang property; she will send a photo to John Singler.

Public Safety Tulio, the city's contract police officer, reported as to trying to stop dumpster early pick up; he is trying to get Metro involved.

Public Works: Comm. Sharon Doll reported that there are street lights out and that she will fix them.

Attorney Report: No report

Engineers Report: Mark sent report that the specifications are ready for Speed Humps and it will be bid out for Spring.

Police Report: None.


Open Comments: None.
