Sanitation: Flyers were put out for survey on how residents want to get their trash and recycling service. There is no urgency in changing service because current contract runs to next year. The Board needs to decide how to handle continuing current service or put out bids for another company.

Public Safety: Quiet



City Clerk: The City received a refund of \$1400 from AT&T for their error in billing. A flyer will go out about leaf pickup in November.


City Attorney: Hopefully the empty houses have been properly boarded up from intruders. They will be checked on periodically.
