REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
JANUARY 8, 2024

Mayor Kenny Griffin opened the regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church.

Roll Call: All present except Mark Madison.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. Com. Knoop made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Com. Taylor. Motion carried.

Reports:

Finance: As of December 31, 2023, total bank accounts and CD was \$422,008.23. Taxes receivable was \$40,685.48. Com. Henry made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Com. Doll, motion carried. She also mentioned that the lights at the Narwood Entrance are not working and she has called our vendor to check it out.

Sanitation: Com. Taylor has received a couple of requests for recycle bins. There was discussion about the trash service and that it is really bad and asked Attorney Singler to come up with specifications next month to bid out a new contract.

Public Safety: Nothing to report.

Public Works: Mailboxes on Axminster have been installed by the residents. A visit by LG&E representative conveyed that the current light on Axminster is sufficient and if the residents want another one, they will have to pay to have it installed. Rueff has put up a new street sign for Axminster Court. LG&E checked out a light on Narwood and a mailbox has been replaced on Narwood.


City Clerk: Information for the audit has been sent to the accountant. A CD came due and it was decided to just roll it over.
