REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
FEBRUARY 10, 2020

Mayor Kenny Griffin opened the regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church.

**City Commissioner Members:** Kenneth Griffin (Mayor), Sharon Doll (Public Works), Sharon Henry (Finance/Landscaping), Gayle Knoop (Safety), and Lydia Moel (Sanitation/Events).

Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: All present except Mark Madison and Lt. Cabrera

The Mayor recognized Mr. Isaacs who stated that he was going to see if Jeffersontown would help dealing with the drainage ditch that is causing problems on his property and others on Merriwood. Mr. Isaacs said the neighbors have given their consent to allow access on their properties for the City to come up with a plan. Hopefully, Jeffersontown would get on board to fix this problem that is in both cities. After some discussion, Com. Henry made a motion to have the City Engineer explore a drainage project on Merriwood, not to exceed \$5000, seconded by Com. Doll.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. Com. Moel made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Com. Henry. Motion carried.

**Reports:**

Finance: Com. Henry stated that the various accounts had a total of \$339,460, with only \$2787 due in 2019 taxes receivable. She then made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Com. Doll.

Sanitation: No issues this past month. Com. Moel made a motion to allow \$500 for the upcoming Easter Egg Hunt, seconded by Com. Henry. Motion carried.

Public Safety: It has been a slow month. An article was included in the most recent newsletter about the possibility of adopting the security Ring Program. The new program should be ready in the 1st quarter of this year and when more information is available, it will be passed on to the residents.

Public Works: Only issue was a street light out.


City Clerk: Property taxes are coming in nicely. She will be out of town for the next meeting.
