The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Commissioner Gayle Knoop to accept, Commissioner Sharon Doll seconded, and all approved.

Reports:

Finance: Comm. Sharon Henry gave the financial report. There is \$315,737.00 in checking and savings accounts. The financial report was discussed and reviewed, motion was made by Commissioner Henry to accept the audit report, seconded by Lydia Moel and the vote in favor was unanimous.

Second reading of Budget ordinance #2 was made. Motion to approve was made by Sharon Henry, seconded by Lydia Moel and all voted in favor by roll call vote.

Sanitation: Lydia Moel reported in the activity in the garbage collection and ordinance enforcement area. There have been some missed pickups that will be reported to the garbage company and other than that it has been quiet.

Public Safety/ Mayor Report: Lt. Cabrera is retiring. The City will discuss another officer is to replace Lt. Cabrera.

Public Works: Comm. Sharon Doll reported on MSD 2309 Janlyn. The grate was put down but it overflowed and pictures were sent to Sharon. Sent Complaints to Joe Exly along with 2219 Janlyn.

There is a problem at 2306 Janlyn of people parking in yard. This continues to be a problem. Need to send a letter that there is no parking in the yard, William Wright. Ring Doorbell program at least five have signed up. Dumpster at 45 Narwood court is gone.


Clerk's Report: There was no clerk's report.

Attorney Report: John Singler informed the Commission that he has sent lots of letters on property conditions, and has had some compliance.


Engineers Report: Mark Madison was not at the meeting.
