REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 9, 2020

Mayor Kenny Griffin opened the regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church.

City Commissioner Members: Kenneth Griffin (Mayor), Sharon Doll (Public Works), Sharon Henry (Finance/Landscaping), Gayle Knoop (Safety), and Lydia Moel (Sanitation/Events).

City Employees: Sgt. Tulio Tourinho (police officer), Pat Cooke (Clerk/Treasurer), John Singler (Attorney) and Mark Madison (City Engineer & Code Enforcement Officer).

Others Present: Resident Gene Clark

Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: All present except Mark Madison

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. A motion was made to approve the minutes by Com. Moel, seconded by Com. Knoop. Motion carried.

Reports:

Finance/Landscaping: As of October 30th, the total of various cash and CD accounts was \$285,217.09. Total liabilities are \$162,274.22 with a net income of \$154,907.79 for the year so far. Com. Henry made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Com. Doll. Motion carried. There were 11 homes that took advantage of the extra leaf pickup this past Wednesday. Additional pickups will be this Tuesday and Wednesday with additional pickups Thanksgiving week. She has asked Kurtzinger to put some holiday lights at the entrances.

Sanitation: Com. Moel stated that the shredding event was a great success. Next year the City may partner with surrounding cities. She suggested a holiday lighting contest again this year. She also would like to make stockings for the City's children and requested a budget of \$300. She then made a motion for the amount, seconded by Com. Knoop. Motion carried.

Public Safety: Com. Knoop reported that there have been a few cases of kids trying to get into cars. Speeding continues on Narwood. A resident did a petition of home owners on Narwood for speed bumps. Com. Knoop will also get signatures on Mahan. Mr. Singler explained the process of getting this project approved.

Public Works: Com. Doll said that the contract for Tommy Sim's doing snow removal has come up for renewal. She made a motion to approve renewal, seconded by Com. Henry. Motion approved.

City Clerk: Called and had the irrigation meters turned off for the winter. She sent in additional information requested for the CRF program. And she mentioned that the City has not heard anything from the accounting firm about the annual audit. Mayor Griffin said he would give them a call.


City Attorney: Nothing to report
