

CITY OF FOREST HILLS
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
JULY 12, 2021

Mayor Kenny Griffin opened the regular meeting at 7:00 p.m. Meeting was held in the Community of Christ Church.

City Commissioner Members: Kenneth Griffin (Mayor), Sharon Doll (Public Works), Sharon Henry (Finance/Landscaping), Gayle Knoop (Safety), and Lydia Moel (Sanitation/Events).

City Employees: Sgt. Tulio Tourinho (police officer), Pat Cooke (Clerk/Treasurer), John Singler (Attorney) and Mark Madison (City Engineer & Code Enforcement Officer).

Others Present:

Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: All present except Mark Madison

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed with one correction being made. Com. Moel made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Com. Henry. Motion carried.

Reports:

Finance: Com. Henry report a total of various accounts at \$320,073.48. The City Clerk mentioned that the checking account at PNC is making no interest. It was discussed to possibly have the account changed to a money market account and Mayor Griffin will look into it. Com. Henry then made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Com. Doll.

Sanitation: There have been complaints about dumpster pickups outside the normal hours. This will be looked into. Com. Moel asked the City Attorney to send a letter to a property owner about a messy yard. A junk pickup is scheduled on Sept. 20th with items being put at the end of the driveway. This will cost the City an additional \$600, and Com. Moel made a motion to accept, seconded by Com. Knoop. The second food truck will be in the City on July 24th.

Public Safety: Speeding continues on Narwood. Com. Knoop is trying to finish up the petition to get 75% agreement to have speed humps put in on Narwood. She feels like she should have enough signatures. There was discussion about having an Enforcement Board to handle fines within the City. Mr. Singler explained that the City would need three people on this board other than elected officials. He will bring information to the next meeting for consideration. Sgt. Tourinho said he would be working on observing the stop signs this coming week.

Public Works: Com. Doll stated that she had ordered new stop signs and will have U.S. Post install them. She has arranged for Rueff to come out and check the sign posts to see if they can be re-furbished. There was some discussion about options for a Holiday meal.




City Attorney: Nothing to report.
